

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Fellowship Best Practices

- Build Fellowship Around Parent Priorities
 - Why the EPC Fellowship focused on Education Data
- Meet Parents Where They Are At
- Foster Connections with Parents and Staff and Between Parents
- Be Flexible
- Design Program with Staff to Get Greater Staff Engagement
- Touch Base with Parents Before and After Sessions



Potential Challenges of a Fellowship

- New Approach to Leadership for Parents and Staff
- Staff Changes
- Parents May Want to Focus on Different Topics than Staff
- Parent Availability May Change
- Virtual or In-Person



- Step 1: Planning
 - What is the goal of the fellowship?
 - How will you define success?
 - What is the budget?
 - What resources do you need?





- Step 2: Recruiting Fellows
 - Personally Recruit Parents who shown leadership and enthusiasm for advocacy
 - Consider various levels of advocacy experience so parents can learn from each other
 - Application process to determine fellowship commitment
 - Application Form
 - Interview



- Step 3: Executing Sessions
 - Provide standing time in advance so Parents can plan
 - Check in with parents before and after each session
 - Proactively reduce potential barriers to participation
 - Interpretation
 - In Person?
 - Food
 - Transportation
 - Childcare
 - Celebrate the Completion of the Fellowship!
