

Child Care Stability Survey

Think Small conducted an anonymous survey of more than 300 metro-area early educators to understand their needs and experiences. Respondents reported increasing absences, decreasing enrollments, and significant increased strain as they navigate families' rising needs and new financial and operational pressures.

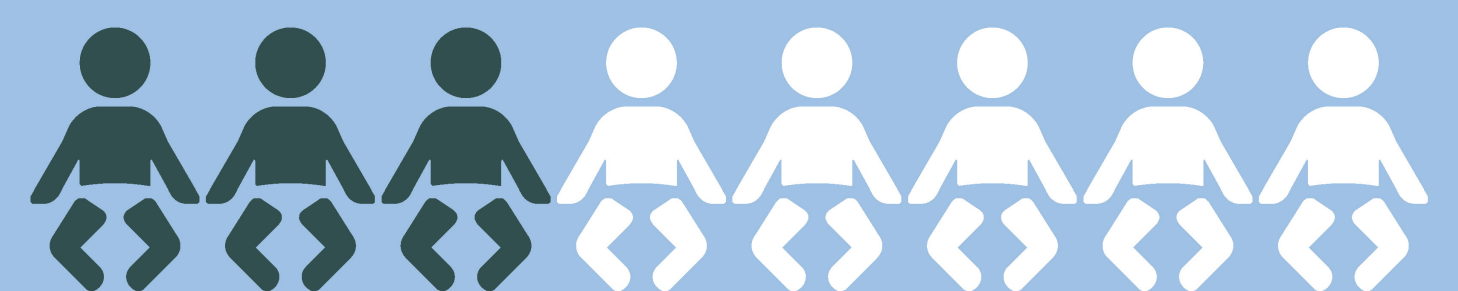

Children using Child Care Assistance or Early Learning Scholarships are allowed 25 days absent in a calendar year.

Of those educators who are serving children using these programs:

41%

say half or more will hit 25 day absent limit

11%

say ALL will hit the 25 day absent limit
